MEA has noted with regret the recent public exchange between the GRTU and MHRA.

While everyone has the right to voice their opinion, no one has the right to use an event by either organization for his own personal agenda. The GRTU Director General was way out of line to use the recent MHRA event as a platform for his attack on the Malta Tourism Authority. His subsequent attack on the same organization was totally uncalled for.

The MHRA representing the main players in the hotel and catering industry has always been at the forefront in the development of tourism in Malta. MHRA has always worked with all stakeholders to ensure the long term sustainability of the sector. The recent efforts, spearheaded by MHRA to give the sector the boost it needed, are now bearing fruit. It has also been at the forefront in the changes needed at the Malta Tourism Authority.
